



Eastford Transfer Station Guide

- Permit:** \$60/year – The sticker should be affixed to the windshield’s lower left-hand corner.
- Location:** 264 Westford Road
860-974-2259
- Hours:** Sat & Sun 8 am – 4 pm
Wed 1 pm – 3 pm
- Source of trash:** Eastford residences and business only. Absolutely no trash from out of town.
- Limit:** 2 cubic yards per week which is roughly one level pickup load.
- Safety:** Children under age 12 and pets must remain in the vehicle.
- At home:** Recycle, Reduce, Reuse! If you can, compost kitchen scraps.
- Questions:** If you are not sure what can be recycled, go to recyclelect.com. This brings you to “Can I recycle it?”, type in an item and instructions are provided.

Separate by Category

- Regular Trash:** Kitchen waste and household trash
- Paper/Cardboard:** Newspaper, Magazines and mail
- Co-mingle:** Food cans/bottles, alum foil, #1-7 plastic, waxed drink cartons
Items smaller than 5 inches are not contracted recyclables. Put pens, nips, straws, bottle caps, plastic utensils, in household trash. Put perfume bottles in bulky waste.

CT 5 cent Cans & Bottles: Empty

- Bulky Waste:** Painted/treated wood, small demo projects, furniture, windows, plumbing fixtures, rugs
- Metal:** Lawnmowers (drained), bicycles, empty paint cans, grills, siding
- Mattresses:** Mattresses and Box Springs
- Electronics A:** Four types per Connecticut Law TV’s, Computers, Monitors, Printers
- Electronics B:** Other plug-ins – Stereos, etc.

Fluorescent Bulbs:

CFL’s, Twists and Tubes

Household Batteries:

Including Flashlight and Toy

Freon Appliances:

Refrigerators, Air Conditioners, Dehumidifiers

Trash to Treasures:

Reusable items only; no mattresses, no food, no meds

Clothes and Shoes:

Clean and wearable

Waste Oil:

eng, hydal, trans; brake fluid.

Oil Filters:

Drained

Antifreeze:

Automotive

Auto Batteries:

Including Lawn Tractor and Motorcycle

Paint:

Latex and oil-based – labeled

Styrofoam:

Clean rigid pieces

Rechargeable Batteries:

Home and Shop

Tires:

Max 20 inches in diameter

Propane Tanks: Designated area only

Brush:

Max 3 inches in diameter

Concrete:

Brick, Clay Pots, Dried Asphalt

Leaves and Grass:

Not Allowed
