Bylaws

Filling Vacancies on the Board

- A. If a vacancy occurs on the Eastford Board of Education (the “Board”), the remaining members of the Board shall fill such vacancy at a meeting, or a special meeting convened for that purpose.
- B. A member resigning from the Board should present, or have presented, a written letter of resignation to the Board Chair or at a regular meeting of the Board.
- C. Having accepted a letter of resignation or having become aware of a vacancy created by means other than the resignation of a Board member, the Board will schedule the election of a replacement at the next regular Board meeting or at a special meeting convened for such purpose.
- D. Said election, made by the majority of the Board, shall be in effect until the next regular Town election, at which a successor shall be elected for the unexpired portion of the term. The official Ballot shall specify the vacancy to be filled.
