

2024 EES Summer Enrichment: Program Support Staff

Description:

Seeking one student support staff member for the 2024 Eastford Elementary School STEM focused summer enrichment program.

The program will be open to two cohorts of 20 students each, for students entering grades 1-6 in 2024-25. The same program will be offered to each cohort. The first program will be offered Tuesdays - Fridays from July 9 through July 19 and the second program will be offered Tuesdays through Fridays from July 30 through August 9. Both programs will run from 8:30 AM–12:30 PM, with students expected to arrive around 8:15 AM. Every Friday there will be a planned offsite trip, (TBD), which will require students to arrive by 8:30 AM, with a return to school at 4:30 PM.

The Sustainable Energy Engineers program developed by Mystic Aquarium will be the primary source for lessons and materials.

Responsibilities:

Assist certified instructional staff with the safe arrival and dismissal of students.
Support the instructional needs of the students so that they may fully engage in and access the summer STEM curriculum.

Compensation:

\$30 dollars per hour. The support staff member is expected to be onsite from 8:15 AM to 12:45 PM on Tuesdays through Thursdays and 8:15 AM through 4:45 PM on Fridays to provide safe arrival and dismissal for students.

It is preferred that the support staff member is available for the entire length of the program but reasonable job-sharing scenarios that are not disruptive to student learning may be considered. Job-sharing applications must be presented as one application document.
